NOTICE OF MAIL BALLOT PROCEDURES TO VOTERS OF GREEN ISLE CITY

IN SIBLEY COUNTY, MINNESOTA

- 1. Beginning in 2020, voters in Green Isle City in Sibley County will vote entirely by mail in statewide and municipal elections as authorized by the township/city under MN Statutes 204B.45. Therefore, this is no longer a polling place for the City of Green Isle.
- 2. For the <u>Statewide Primary</u>, election date August 11, 2020, ballots were automatically mailed to voters in the precinct who were registered to vote before July 21, 2020.
- 3. Voted ballots must be received at the Sibley County Courthouse no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day in order to be counted.
- 4. If you did not mail your ballot or deliver it previously, you may bring your voted ballot, in the appropriate envelope, directly to the County Auditor-Treasurer's office at the address listed below before 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 11, 2020.
- 5. If you did not receive a ballot in the mail you are not currently a registered voter. You may come to the County Auditor-Treasurer's office on election day where you can register and vote a ballot.
- 6. The polls at the courthouse will be open for the <u>Statewide Primary</u>: Tuesday, August 11, 2020 from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. At least one assistive voting device will be available at the courthouse, allowing for persons with disabilities to vote privately and independently.
- 7. All mail ballots will be counted at the Sibley County Courthouse after 8:00 p.m. on August 11, 2020.
