

NOTICE OF MAIL BALLOT PROCEDURES TO VOTERS OF GREEN ISLE CITY

IN SIBLEY COUNTY, MINNESOTA

1. Beginning in 2020, voters in Green Isle City in Sibley County will vote entirely by mail in statewide and municipal elections as authorized by the township/city under MN Statutes 204B.45. Therefore, this is no longer a polling place for the City of Green Isle.
2. For the Statewide Primary, election date August 11, 2020, ballots were automatically mailed to voters in the precinct who were registered to vote before July 21, 2020.
3. Voted ballots must be received at the Sibley County Courthouse no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day in order to be counted.
4. If you did not mail your ballot or deliver it previously, you may bring your voted ballot, in the appropriate envelope, directly to the County Auditor-Treasurer's office at the address listed below before 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 11, 2020.
5. If you did not receive a ballot in the mail you are not currently a registered voter. You may come to the County Auditor-Treasurer's office on election day where you can register and vote a ballot.
6. The polls at the courthouse will be open for the Statewide Primary: Tuesday, August 11, 2020 from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. At least one assistive voting device will be available at the courthouse, allowing for persons with disabilities to vote privately and independently.
7. All mail ballots will be counted at the Sibley County Courthouse after 8:00 p.m. on August 11, 2020.
