ORDINANCE NO. <u>2007-05</u>

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING AND PROHIBITING CERTAIN PUBLIC NUISANCES WITHIN THE CITY OF GREEN ISLE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN ISLE, MINNESOTA TO PROMOTE THE PUBLIC SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELFARE, HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

In the interest of public health and safety, and to guarantee the peaceful and reasonable enjoyment of property rights by the citizens of Green Isle, the City Council hereby declares that the following described conduct is a public nuisance and shall be a violation of the law. This Ordinance amends and supersedes Ordinance 93.

Section 1: Any person who causes or allows loud music or other disturbing noises in a residential zone in an unreasonable manner or at unreasonable hours which would tend to alarm or disturb the peace and tranquility of others shall be guilty of creating or maintaining a public nuisance. Any person creating or maintaining noise or music sources loud enough to be heard by other persons inside their homes, any time between the hours of 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. shall be considered prima facie a public nuisance.

Section 2: Any person found guilty of violating this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, subject to the penalties for a misdemeanor set out in Minnesota State law.

Section 3: All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication.
