

Ordinance No. 13.

An ordinance requiring a sidewalk built on Parnell and McGrann streets:

The Village Council of the Village of Green Isle, Sibley County, Minnesota, do ordain

SEC. 1. That in compliance with a petition therefor duly presented to the Village Council of the Village of Green Isle, signed by the required number of real estate owners, fronting on said streets, it is hereby ordered that a sidewalk be built in said Village as follows:

A sidewalk six (6) feet wide on the north side of Parnell and McGrann streets, commencing at South-East corner of Lot (8) eight; Block (1) one, McGrann's addition to Green Isle, thence running East on said streets to the first gate entrance to the church, there terminating.

SEC. 2. That the sidewalk mentioned in Section 1 of this ordinance be constructed of good sound plank not less than one and one-half inches in thickness and not more than twelve inches wide, laid upon three stringers, said stringers to be not less than 2x6 inches in dimension; and to be laid on the ground or upon a solid foundation and to be constructed of good sound white oak or pine plank.

SEC. 3. That all the expenses of building and constructing said sidewalk be and the same is hereby ordered paid by the owners of the real estate bounding the streets opposite where said sidewalk is required to be built fronting on same.

SEC. 4. Said sidewalk to be laid on, or as near as possible to the grade established for same by Adam Buck, county surveyor of Sibley county, Minnesota.

SEC. 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
