

Ordinance No. 15

An ordinance fixing the License Fee for the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors and Limiting the Number of Saloons.

The Village Council of the Village of Green Isle ordains:

Section 1. Any person applying for license to sell intoxicating liquors of any kind in the village of Green Isle shall before the same is issued to him, pay to Village Treasurer of said Village of Green Isle the sum of Six Hundred sixty seven (\$667.00) Dollars for said license.

Section 2. The total number of licenses for the sale of intoxicating liquors in force in the Village of Green Isle at any time shall not exceed three in number.

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.
