

An Ordinance providing for the regulation and licensing of the business of vendors at retail of non-intoxicating beverages within the village of Green Isle Minnesota, prescribing a license fee therefor, and providing penalties for the violation thereof.

The village council of the Village of Green Isle do ordain as follows:

Sec.1. It is hereby declared unlawful for any person or persons to engage in the business of vendor at retail of non-intoxicating beverages within the village of Green Isle, Minnesota, unless he shall be first licensed so to do as hereinafter provided.

Sec.2. Any person desiring to engage in the business of vendor at retail of non-intoxicating beverages within said village shall make and file his written application with the village clerk stating in such application that he desires to engage in such business, describing the premises where such business is to be conducted, and shall deposit with the clerk the fee for such license, which is hereby fixed at the sum of \$ 50.00; and shall execute his bond to the village with good and sufficient sureties to be approved by the council in the sum of 300 five hundred dollars, conditioned that he will in all respects obey the provisions of this ordinance and the laws of the State of Minnesota.

Sec.3. At the next meeting of the village council occurring after the filing of such application the clerk shall lay such application before the council, and if the council finds that such applicant is of good moral character, and has not within one year previous been convicted of any violation of the liquor laws, and that the premises are suitable for said business, and such bond be approved, it may grant said license, which shall be issued by the clerk and signed by the clerk and the President of the Council, and shall be in force and effect for one year from the date of issuance, unless sooner revoked for cause as hereinafter provided.

Sec.4. It shall be the duty of the person conducting such business to all times keep and maintain a quiet and orderly place, and to permit no gambling, loud and boisterous conduct, or drinking of intoxicating liquors on said premises, and to permit no person to bring any intoxicating liquors on said premises; and no screens, shades stands or obstructions whatever which obstructs the view into said premises from the outside shall be permitted or used either in the room where such business is conducted or in the rooms communicating or used in connection therewith, and upon violation of any regulation herein provided the council may revoke such license at any time. After such revocation no license shall be issued to such person for the period of one year thereafter and the license fee theretofore paid shall be forfeited; nor shall any license to conduct said business in the same premises be issued to any person until after the expiration of the period for which said license so revoked was originally issued, without unanimous vote of the entire council.

Sec.5. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by a fine of not less than \$ 25.00, nor more than \$ 100.00, or by imprisonment in the county jail for not less than 10 days nor more than 60 days.

Sec.6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
