

AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

..... being duly sworn, deposes and says that he now is and during all the times hereinafter mentioned has been the publisher or printer in charge of the Green Isle Record, a weekly newspaper, printed and published in the Village of Green Isle in said Sibley County, State of Minnesota, on Friday of each week;

That he has knowledge of the facts and knows personally that the printed... Ordinances No. 24-25-26-27..... hereto attached, cut from the columns of said newspaper, was inserted, printed and published in said newspaper once each week for one weeks, and that all of said publications were made in the English language.

That said notice was first inserted, printed and published on Friday, the 13th day of September 1929, and was printed and published in said newspaper on each and every Friday thereafter until and including Friday, the 19th day of September 1929.

That during all the times aforesaid, said newspaper was qualified as a medium of official and legal publications as required by sections 3 and 4 of chapter 484, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1921, and that it has complied with all the requirements that constitute a legal newspaper as defined in said sections 3 and 4, to-wit: that for more than one year last past from the date of the first publication of said Ordinances, said newspaper has been

- (1) Printed from the place from which it purports to be issued in the English language and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least four pages, with five columns to the page, each seventeen and three quarters inches long
- (2) Issued once each week from a known office, established in such place for publication and equipped with skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same
- (3) Made up to contain general and local news, comment and miscellany, not wholly duplicating any other publication, and not entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements, or any or either of them.
- (4) Circulated in and near its place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, and that prior to the date of the first publication of said Ordinances the publisher or printer in charge of said newspaper having knowledge of the facts, filed in the office of the county auditor of said County of Sibley, State of Minnesota, an affidavit showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper as required and set forth in section 3 of chapter 484, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1921.

The following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z, both inclusive, of the size and kind of type used in the composition, printing and publication of said legal advertisement hereunto attached, viz:

ORDINANCE NO. 24

An Ordinance to provide for the manner of constructing sidewalks in the village of Green Isle, in Sibley County, Minnesota.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREEN ISLE, MINNESOTA DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All sidewalks in said village of Green Isle, hereafter to be constructed, unless otherwise specially ordered by the village council, shall be four feet and six inches in width, excepting along Lots 12, 13, 14, and 15 in block No. 2 McGrann's Addition East Side of lot 9 in block 2 McGrann's 2nd Addition and the East side of lot 10 block 2 McGrann's 3rd Addition where said sidewalks shall be 6 feet in width; and shall be constructed either of concrete or cement blocks placed on a firm foundation and so as to make a level surface. The side of the sidewalks toward the lots along which same are built must be two (2) feet from the lot line, and must be constructed to a grade line to be established by the village council for that purpose and be made to conform to this ordinance under the Council's direction.

Section 2. No sidewalk not constructed in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance shall be accepted by the street commissioner or other officer or officers of said village, unless otherwise specially ordered by the Council.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
