

An Ordinance providing for the licensing of Transient Dealers, Hawkers and Peddlers, and fixing the license fees for same.

The Village Council of the village of Green Isle, in Sibley County Minnesota, to ordain as follows:

Section 1. That no transient dealer, hawker or peddler shall be allowed to do business, or attempt to do business in the village of Green Isle, Minnesota, without first securing a license for the carrying on of such business as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. Any person who desires to engage in any such business in said village shall before he transacts any business therein make a written application for license to transact business therein, which application shall describe the nature and kind of business to be transacted, and shall be filed with the village clerk.

Section 3. The license fee for any transient dealer hawker or peddler doing business or attempting to do business in said village shall be twenty five (\$25.00) dollars pr day for each day such business is transacted or attempted to be transacted, and shall be paid to the village clerk when the license is issued. Provided that no applicant for such license shall be required to pay more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) during any one year for the carrying on of any one business.

Section 4. Any person having paid for a license as hereinbefore specified shall be entitled to have the amount paid for such license refunded to him provided he stays in said village one year continuously or when his property has been regularly assessed in said village and he has paid taxes thereon in said village.

Section 5. It shall be the duty of the village clerk to receive and file all applications made hereunder and to issue all licenses as herein provided.

Section 6. Any person ~~found guilty of~~ violating any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not less than twenty five dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, and upon default of the payment of such fine shall be imprisoned in the county jail of said county for not exceeding ninety days.

Section 7. All ordinances or parts or ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication.
