Amendment to Ordinance No. 32

The members of the Village Council of the Village of Green Isle met at its regular session this 8th day of Feb 1960 do hereby ordiain as follows: An amendment to amend Section 3 Paragraph D which is entitled and Ordinance to Amend No 32 which was passed April 7, 1947, entitled an Ordinance Governing the Water Works System of the Village of Green Isle, Minn. establishing Water Rates, Rules Gegulations & Penalties for the Coverment of Water takers, Plumbers & oth ers.

Paragraph B & D of Section 3 is hereby amended to read as follows: That the minimum fee per quarter furnished to owners or occupants of residences with a meter shall be \$4.50. Without a meter for residents it shall be \$5.00. Minimum fee per quarter for business extablishments without a meter shall be \$10.00 otherwise the same as residents. That the rates per galhonrore one thousand gallons shall be raised to as follows:

First 6000 gals at 80¢ per thousand Next 6000 gals at 70¢ per thousand Next 6000 gals at 60¢ per thousand Then on at 30¢ per thousand.

These rases are effective as of April 1, 1960.
