ORDINANCE NO. 35

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 17 OF THE VILLAGE OF GREEN ISLE, SIBLEY COUNTY, MINNESOTA, PASSED OCTOBER 2, 1916, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE, GRANTING PERMISSION TO NORTHERN STATES POWER COMPANY, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS TO ERECT AND MAINTAIN IN THE VILLAGE OF GREEN ISLE TRANSMISSION LINES AND ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM, INCLUDING NECESSARY POLE LINES AND FIXTURES FOR THE FURNISHING OF CURRENT TO THE VILLAGE, AND ITS INHABITANCE AND OF TRANSMITTING CURRENT THROUGH THE VILLAGE, AND PRESCRIBING MAXIMUM RATES THEREFOR, AND TO USE THE STREETS, ALLEYS, AND PUBLIC GROUNDS OF SAID VILLAGE FOR SUCH PURPOSES." THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREEN ISLE, MINNESOTA, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 17 passed and adopted October 2, 1916, be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the whole of said section 2 thereof and inserting in lieu thereof, and the whole thereof, the following, to wit:

"Section 2. That the rates to be charged by the Grantee herein, its successors and assigns, for the electric energy sold within said Village, shall be reasonable and shall not exceed the Company's standard schedule of rates and minimum charges effective for and in communities of like size in adjoining territory which are similarly served and situated."

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication and the filing by the Northern States Power Company, its successors or assigns, of its unconditional acceptance thereof, with the Village Clerk within sixty (60) days from the date of the passage hereof.

the date of the first publication of said Ordinance No. 35, said newspaper has been

(1) Printed from the place from which it purports to be issued in the English language and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least four pages, with five columns to the page, each seventeen and three quarters inches long

(2) Issued once each week from a known office, established in such place for publication and equipped with skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same

(3) Made up to contain general and local news, comment and miscellany, not wholly duplicating any other publication, and not entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements, or any or either of them.

(4) Circulated in and near its place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, and that prior to the date of the

first publication of said Ordinance No. 35 the publisher or printer in charge of said newspaper having knowledge of the facts, filed in the office of the county auditor of said County of Sibley, State of Minnesota, an affidavit showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper as required and set forth in section 3 of chapter 484, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1921.
