ORDINANCE NO. 38

VILLAGE OF GREEN ISLE, COUN-TY OF SIBLEY, MINNESOTA. An Ordinance to amend Section 11 and 15 of Ordiance No. 30, passed April 4, 1933, entitled, An Ordinance relating to the sale of Non-Intoxicating Malt Liquors. amended to read as follows:

Section 11. No sale of either Off or On Sale License can be made between the hours of twelve o'clock P. M. and six o'clock A. M., or on any election day.

Section 15. Striking out all of Section 15 except the following: No person shall be granted a license to operate in any resident home.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and its publication.
