

AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

ORDINANCE NO. 39

VILLAGE OF GREEN ISLE, SIBLEY COUNTY, MINNESOTA. An Ordinance to amend Section 1, Column A of Ordinance No. 31, passed February 26th, 1934, entitled: An Ordinance licensing and regulating the sale of intoxicating liquor repealing inconsistent ordinances and providing a penalty for the violation thereof. Section 1. Column A is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. On-Sale license shall permit the licensee to sell such intoxicating liquor for consumption on the licensed premises, the license fees therefor shall be Three Hundred and Fifty (\$350.00) Dollars per annum. Not more than two On-Sale licenses shall be granted to persons applying therefor in the Village of Green Isle.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force starting June 30, 1940.

Adopted by the Village Council of the Village of Green Isle, Sibley County, Minnesota, this first day of April, 1940.

being duly sworn, deposes and says that he now is and during all the times hereinafter mentioned has been the publisher or printer in charge of the Green Isle Record, a weekly newspaper, printed and published in the Village of Green Isle in said Sibley County, State of Minnesota, on Friday of each week;

That he has knowledge of the facts and knows personally that the printed Ordinance No. 39 from the columns of said newspaper, was inserted, printed and published in said newspaper once each week for one weeks, and that all of said publications were made in the English language.

That said notice was first inserted, printed and published on Friday, the 5th day of April 1940, and was printed and published in said newspaper on each and every Friday thereafter until and including Friday, the day of 1930.

That during all the times aforesaid, said newspaper was qualified as a medium of official and legal publications as required by sections 3 and 4 of chapter 484, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1921, and that it has complied with all the requirements that constitute a legal newspaper as defined in said sections 3 and 4, to-wit: that for more than one year last past from

the date of the first publication of said Ordinance No. 39, said newspaper has been

(1) Printed from the place from which it purports to be issued in the English language and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least four pages, with five columns to the page, each seventeen and three quarters inches long

(2) Issued once each week from a known office, established in such place for publication and equipped with skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same

(3) Made up to contain general and local news, comment and miscellany, not wholly duplicating any other publication, and not entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements, or any or either of them.

(4) Circulated in and near its place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, and that prior to the date of the

first publication of said Ordinance No. 39 the publisher or printer in charge of said newspaper having knowledge of the facts, filed in the office of the county auditor of said County of Sibley, State of Minnesota, an affidavit showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper as required and set forth in section 3 of chapter 484, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1921.

The following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z, both inclusive, of the size and kind of type used in the composition, printing and publication of said legal advertisement hereunto attached, viz:
