ORDINANCE NO. 39

VILLAGE OF GREEN ISLE, SIB-LEY COUNTY, MINNESOTA. An Ordinance to amend Section 1, Column A of Ordinance No. 31, passed February 26th, 1934, entitled: An Ordinance licensing and regulating the sale of intoxicating liquor repealing inconsistent ordinances and providing a penalty for the violation thereof. Section 1. Column A is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. On-Sale license shall permit the licensee to sell such intoxicating liquor for consumption on the licensed premises, the license fees therefor shall be Three Hundred and Fifty (\$350.00) Dollars per annum. Not more than two On-Sale licenses shall be granted to persons applying therefor in the Village of Green Isle.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force starting June 30, 1940.
