

**Ordinance No. 4.**

An ordinance requiring a sidewalk built on Parnell Street.  
The Village Council of the Village of Green Isle do ordain as follows:

SEC. 1.—That in compliance with a petition therefor duly presented to the Village Council of the Village of Green Isle, signed by the requisite number of real estate owners it is hereby ordered that a sidewalk be built in said village as follows:

A sidewalk Six (6) feet wide on the North side of Parnell street from the Southwest corner of lot number Four (4) to the Southeast corner of lot number eight (8) across the South side of block number one (1) in McGrann's addition to Green Isle, and a sidewalk Six (6) feet wide on the South side of Parnell street from the Northeast corner of lot number one (1) to the Northwest corner of lot number eight (8), across the North side of block number two (2) in McGrann's addition to Green Isle.

SEC. 2.—That the sidewalk mentioned in Sec. one (1) of this ordinance be constructed of plank not less than one and one-half inches in thickness, and not more than twelve inches wide laid upon three stringers, said stringers to be not less than 2x4 inches in dimension and to be laid on the ground or upon a solid foundation, and to be constructed of good sound white oak or pine plank.

SEC. 3.—That all the expenses of building and constructing said sidewalk be and the same is hereby ordered paid by the owners of the real estate bounding the street opposite where said sidewalk is required to be built and fronting on the same.

SEC. 4.—Said sidewalk to be laid on, or as near as practicable, to the grade established for same by Adam Buck, County Surveyor of Sibley County, Minnesota.

SEC. 5.—This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
