

AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

Ordinance No. 40

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN ADJACENT LAND TO THE VILLAGE OF GREEN ISLE, MINNESOTA, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the following described land beginning One Hundred and Ninety Eight (198) feet West of the Northwest corner of Lot One (1), Block Five (5) of Fitzpatrick's Addition to the Village of Green Isle, Minnesota, thence South One Hundred Thirty Two (132) feet, thence West Sixty Six (66) feet, thence North One Hundred Thirty Two (132) feet, thence East along the South side of Cleveland avenue Sixty Six (66) feet to the place of beginning, all in the Southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of Section Eighteen (18), Township One Hundred Fourteen (114), Range Twenty Six (26), Sibley County, Minnesota, abutting upon the incorporated Village of Green Isle, be and the same is hereby annexed to said Village and shall become a part of said Village as effectually as if said land had been originally a part thereof

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its adoption and publication, and a certified copy duly filed with the County Auditor and the Secretary of State as provided by law.

being duly sworn, deposes and says that he now is and during all the times hereinafter mentioned has been the publisher or printer in charge of the Green Isle Record, a weekly newspaper, printed and published in the Village of Green Isle in said Sibley County, State of Minnesota, on Friday of each week;

That he has knowledge of the facts and knows personally that the printed Village Ordinance No. 40 hereto attached, cut from the columns of said newspaper, was inserted, printed and published in said newspaper once each week for one weeks, and that all of said publications were made in the English language.

That said notice was first inserted, printed and published on Friday, the 27th day of September, 1940, and was printed and published in said newspaper on each and every Friday thereafter until and including Friday, the day of 193.....

That during all the times aforesaid, said newspaper was qualified as a medium of official and legal publications as required by sections 3 and 4 of chapter 484, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1921, and that it has complied with all the requirements that constitute a legal newspaper as defined in said sections 3 and 4, to-wit: that for more than one year last past from

the date of the first publication of said Ordinance, said newspaper has been

(1) Printed from the place from which it purports to be issued in the English language and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least four pages, with five columns to the page, each seventeen and three quarters inches long

(2) Issued once each week from a known office, established in such place for publication and equipped with skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same

(3) Made up to contain general and local news, comment and miscellany, not wholly duplicating any other publication, and not entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements, or any or either of them.

(4) Circulated in and near its place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, and that prior to the date of the

first publication of said Ordinance the publisher or printer in charge of said newspaper having knowledge of the facts, filed in the office of the county auditor of said County of Sibley, State of Minnesota, an affidavit showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper as required and set forth in section 3 of chapter 484, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1921.

The following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z, both inclusive, of the size and kind of type used in the composition, printing and publication of said legal advertisement hereunto attached, viz:
