VILLAGE OF GREEN SIBLEY COUNTY, MINNESOTA. An Ordnance to Amend Section A of Ordnance No. 41 which is entiled, An Ordnance to Amend Section 1, Column A which was passed Feb. 25th, 1934, entitled An Ordnance licensing and re gulating the sale of intoxicating liquor repealing inconsistent ordnances and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

Section A of Ordnance No. 41, said Ordnance No. 41 being passed on the 3rd day of June 1946 which provides that On Sale Lice ise shall permit the Licensee to sell such intoxicating liquor for consumption on the licensed premises, the license fees thereof shall be Six Hundred Fifty and no-100 Dollars (\$650.00) per annum. Not more than two On-sale licenses shall be granted to persons applying thereof in the Village of Green Isle, shall be amended to read as follows:

A On-sale license shall permit the Licensee to sell such intoxicating liquor for consumption on the premises, the lice use fees the reof shall be Seven HundredFifty and no.100 Dollars (\$750.00) per annum. ot more than two On-sale licenses shall be granted to persons applying thereof in the Village of Green

This Ordnance shall take effect and be in force from and after June 30th, 1947.
