

# Ordinance No. 43

VILLAGE OF GREEN ISLE  
SIBLEY COUNTY, MINNESOTA.  
An Ordinance to Amend Section A of Ordinance No. 41 which is entitled, An Ordinance to Amend Section 1, Column A which was passed Feb. 25th, 1934, entitled An Ordinance licensing and regulating the sale of intoxicating liquor repealing inconsistent ordinances and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

Section A of Ordinance No. 41, said Ordinance No. 41 being passed on the 3rd day of June 1946 which provides that On Sale License shall permit the Licensee to sell such intoxicating liquor for consumption on the licensed premises, the license fees thereof shall be Six Hundred Fifty and no-100 Dollars (\$650.00) per annum. Not more than two On-sale licenses shall be granted to persons applying thereof in the Village of Green Isle, shall be amended to read as follows:

A On-sale license shall permit the Licensee to sell such intoxicating liquor for consumption on the premises, the license fees thereof shall be Seven Hundred Fifty and no-100 Dollars (\$750.00) per annum. Not more than two On-sale licenses shall be granted to persons applying thereof in the Village of Green Isle.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after June 30th, 1947.

F. H. Groetsch, being duly sworn, on oath says; that he is, and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher of the newspaper known as Green Isle Record, and has full knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated; that for more than one year prior to the publication therein of the Ordinance No. 43 hereinafter described, said newspaper was printed and published in the Village of Green Isle, in the County of Sibley, State of Minnesota, on Friday of each week; that during all said time said newspaper has been printed in the English language from its known office of publication within the Village from which it purports to be issued

as above stated and in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least 450 running inches of single column, two inches wide; has been issued once each week from a known office established in said place of publication and employing skilled workmen and equipped with the necessary material for preparing and printing the same, and the presswork on that part of the newspaper devoted to local news of interest to the community which it purports to serve has been done in its known office of publication; that during all said time in its makeup not less than twenty-five percent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve; that during all said time it has not wholly duplicated any other publication, and has not been entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements; has been circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty (240) copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and has entry as second class matter in its local post office; and

that there has been on file in the office of the County Auditor of Sibley County, Minnesota, the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper.

That the Ordinance hereto attached was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published therein in the English language, once each week, for two successive weeks; that it was first so published on Friday the 20th day of June 1947; and thereafter on Friday of each week to and including the 27th day of June 1947; and that the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being the size and kind of type used in the composition and publication of said notice, to-wit:
