

# Ordinance No. 45

VILLAGE OF GREEN ISLE, SIBLEY COUNTY, MINNESOTA. An Ordinance to amend Section A of Ordinance No. 43 which is entitled, An Ordinance to Amend Section I Column A which was passed Feb. 2nd, 1934, entitled An Ordinance licensing and regulating the sale of intoxicating liquor repealing inconsistent ordinance and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

Section A of Ordinance No. 43, said Ordinance No. 43 being passed on the 2nd day of June 1947, which provides that the On-Sale License shall permit the Licensee to sell such intoxicating liquors for consumption on the licensed premises, the license fees thereof shall be Seven Hundred Fifty and No-100 Dollars (\$750.00) per annum. Not more than two On Sale licenses shall be granted to persons applying therefor in the Village of Green Isle, shall be amended to read as follows:

A. On-Sale license shall permit the licensee to sell such intoxicating liquors for consumption on the premises, the license fees thereof shall be Nine Hundred and No-100 Dollars (\$900.00) per annum. Not more than two On Sale licenses shall be granted to persons applying therefor in the Village of Green Isle

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after June 30th, 1948.

lication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty (240) copies regularly delivered

to paying subscribers and has entry as second class matter in its local post office; and

that there has been on file in the office of the County Auditor of.....Sibley.....

County, Minnesota, the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the

name and location of said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its

qualifications as a legal newspaper.
