ORDINANCE NO. 59
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF GREEN ISLE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCOR-PORATED AND UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated August 28th, 1974, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council on the 30th day of August, 1974; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of the land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 4.79 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by the sole owner of said land; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of

the land to be annexed; and WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the city limits at the east boundary

thereof;

The Council of the City of Green Isle, Minnesota, ordains: Section 1. The city Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the city and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is about to become urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexted to and included within the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part there-

A parcel of land in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE1/4 of SE 1/4) of Section Number Eighteen (18) in Township Number One Hundred Fourteen (114) North of Range Number Twenty-six (26), described as follows:
