

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE
CITY OF GREEN ISLE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED
TERRITORY BORDERED BY LAND WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS AND
ABUTTING THEREON

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city or borough; and

WHEREAS, sixty per cent (60%) or more of the perimeter of this territory is bordered by lands already included within the corporate limits of the city and is deemed to be urban in character;

The City Council of the City of Green Isle ordains;

Section 1. Territory annexed. The corporate limits of the City of Green Isle, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory described as follows, 60% or more of which territory is already included within the city limits:

The East 33 feet of the North 25 chains of the Southeast Quarter of Section Number Thirteen (13), Township Number One Hundred Fourteen (114) North, Range Number Twenty-seven (27) West, Sibley County, Minnesota, and that part of Trunk Highway No. 5 right-of-way lying northerly of the South line of the North 25 Chains of said Southeast Quarter and westerly of the East line of said Southeast Quarter more particularly bounded as follows:

On the East by the East line of said Southeast Quarter
On the North by the North line of said Southeast Quarter
On the West by the easterly lines of Michaletz First Addition,
Michaletz Second Addition and Michaletz Third Addition all
according to the recorded plats thereof
On the South by the South line of the North 25 Chains of said
Southeast Quarter.

Section 2. Filing. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the county in which the property is located, the Town Clerk of the affected township and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 3. Effective date of annexation. This Ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.

the Owner publisher and printer of the newspaper known as Arlington Enterprise and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50 percent of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75 percent of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Arlington in the County of Sibley and it has its known office of issue in the City of Arlington in said county, established and open during regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the publisher of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966, and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the publisher of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.
