

ORDINANCE NO. 63
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION AND USE OF
SNOWMOBILES IN THE CITY OF GREEN ISLE AND IMPOSING
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

THE CITY COUNCIL OF GREEN ISLE, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.

Shall be as defined in Minnesota Statutes Section 84.81, Subdivision 1 to 11, both inclusive.

SECTION 2. REGISTRATION.

All snowmobiles operated within the City of Green Isle shall be registered according to Minnesota Statutes Sec. 84.81 to Sec. 84.82, Subdivision 1, both inclusive. For the purpose of this ordinance, Minnesota Statutes Sec. 84.82, Subdivision 2 to 8, inclusive, and 84.821 to 84.86, shall not be included or binding.

SECTION 3. OPERATION

A. For the purpose of this Ordinance, Minnesota Statutes Sec. 84.87 to 84.872, both inclusive, shall be included in their entirety.

B. Snowmobiles shall not be operated on any sidewalk or boulevard, nor shall they be operated on or across any private property without the consent of the owner. However, snowmobiles may be permitted to cross a sidewalk at a 90° angle, after yielding to all persons using such sidewalk, but only for the purpose of gaining access to a roadway or street.

C. Snowmobiles may not be operated on any street adjacent to any church while services are in progress or on any street adjacent to any school while classes are in session. No snowmobile shall be operated on any cemetery land or city park or recreation area. No snowmobile shall be operated on any school property without the consent of the school board.

D. All snowmobiles shall at all times yield to the right of way to pedestrians and oncoming traffic and at intersections with restricted vision, shall come to a complete stop before crossing.

E. Snowmobiles may use any city street, except state or county state aid roads as defined in Minnesota Statutes 84.87, but only for the purpose of entering or leaving town by the most direct route or when traveling to or from a repair shop for repairs. Snowmobiles shall be operated as far to the right side of a street or roadway as possible, in single file only and at a speed not to exceed 15 miles per hour.

F. Snowmobiles shall be permitted to operate in the City after 10 P. M. only to return to operator's home base from a destination outside the city limits by the shortest route only. No snowmobile shall be operated anywhere in the City except in an emergency, between the hours of 1 A. M. and 7 A. M., except on Friday and Saturday nights. No person shall operate or permit to be operated any snowmobile engine for the purpose of repair or maintenance after 10 P. M.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

SECTION 5. PENALTY

Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days, or both.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage and publication.

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AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

(1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches.
(2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week.
(3) Said newspaper has 50 percent of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements.
(4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75 percent of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office.
(5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Arlington in the County of Sibley and it has its known office of issue in the City of Arlington in said county, established and open during regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the publisher of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed.
(6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society.
(7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below.
(8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966, and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the publisher of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.
