

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF
THE CITY OF GREEN ISLE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED
UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING
UPON THE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated October 10th, 1975, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council of the City of Green Isle, Minnesota, on the 14th day of October, 1975; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 3.52 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by the sole owner of said land; and
WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the city limits on the west and north boundaries thereof;

The Council of the City of Green Isle, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the city and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is about to become urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

The west 368.3 feet of the South 416.50 feet of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eighteen (18), Township One Hundred Fourteen (114) North, Range Twenty-six (26) West, including abutting roads and rights of way, and containing 3.52 acres of land, Sibley County, Minnesota.

Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, the Town Clerk and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.

(3) Said newspaper has 50 percent of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75 percent of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Arlington in the County of Sibley and it has during regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the publisher of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966, and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the publisher of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.
