

AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT THE CARRYING AND  
DISCHARGING OF FIREARMS, THE USE OF SLING  
SHOTS, BOWS AND ARROWS, AIR RIFLES AND BB  
GUNS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF GREEN ISLE,  
MINNESOTA

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN ISLE, MINNESOTA, DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Definition - Deadly Weapons. The term "deadly weapons" as used herein shall include the following: (1) All firearms; (2) Bows and arrows when arrows are pointed tipped; (3) All instruments used to expell at high velocity any pellets of any kind, including but not limited to BB guns and air rifles; (4) Sling shots; (5) Metal knuckles; and (6) daggers and knives.

SECTION 2. - Except as herein specifically authorized, all discharging and use of deadly weapons within the City of Green Isle are hereby prohibited.

SECTION 3. - The aiming of any deadly weapon, whether loaded or not, at or toward any human being is hereby prohibited.

SECTION 4. - The selling, giving, loaning, or furnishing in any way of any deadly weapon to a minor under the age of 18 years without the written consent of his parents or guardian is hereby prohibited.

SECTION 5. - No minor under the age of 14 years shall handle or have in his possession or under his control, except while accompanied by or under the immediate charge of his parent or guardian, any deadly weapon.

SECTION 6. - The possession by any person other than a Police Officer of any deadly weapon concealed or furtively carried on the person is hereby prohibited.

SECTION 7. - Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to include any firing of a gun or use of other weapons when done in the lawful defense of persons or property or family, or the necessary enforcement of the law.

SECTION 8. - Subject to reasonable regulation by the City Council for the protection of persons and property, the Police Department may issue special permits to duly organized clubs and their members for practicing on grounds selected for that purpose, or to persons firing salutes over the graves of deceased persons.


SECTION 9 - It shall be unlawful for parent or guardian of any child under the age of 18 years knowingly to permit such child to carry any air rifle, air gun, sling shot or bow and arrow in the City of Green Isle unless said gun, pistol or firearm is dis-mounted or broken apart, or carried in a case in such manner that it cannot be discharged.

SECTION 10. - No permits issued under this chapter shall be deemed valid unless they be in writing and in the possession of the person using the permit.

SECTION 11. - Any person violating this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor, and in addition thereto, any weapons used or carried shall be seized and impounded and sold by order of any court of competent jurisdiction.

SECTION 12 - This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

(8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966, and each signed by the publisher of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.
