

ORDINANCE NO. 68
AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING EXHIBITION
DRIVING IN THE CITY OF GREEN ISLE

The City Council of the City of Green Isle, Minnesota, does ordain:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS - For the purpose of this Ordinance the following words shall have the definition herein recited:

(a) Motor Vehicle - shall mean any self-propelled motor vehicle on wheels which would ordinarily travel on public streets.

(b) Public or Private Way - shall mean any street, avenue, highway or other public way, private driveway or other private way in the City of Green Isle, Minnesota.

SECTION 2. No person shall start or accelerate a motor vehicle on a public or private way within the City of Green Isle in such a way as to unreasonably squeal the tires or throw sand or gravel with the tires.

SECTION 3. No person shall start or accelerate a motor vehicle in such a manner that black tire marks are left on the pavement at or near the point of starting or accelerating said motor vehicle.

SECTION 4. Penalty - Any violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be a misdemeanor.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE - This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
