AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO

OPERATING TIME OF

Section 1. WEEKCDAY HOURS OF
OPERATION 2 Any licensee holding a
weekday intoxicating liquor license
under city ordinance shall have the right
to sell intoxicating beverages as their
license allows, between the hours of 8
a.m. and 1 a.m. from Monday through
Saturday. No sale of intoxicating beverages shall take place at any other time
on weekdays or on Sunday at any time section. for the licensees mentioned in this

Section 2. SUNDAY HOURS OF OPERATION: Any licensee granted a Sunday intoxicating liquor license under city ordinance shall have the right to sell intoxicating beverages between the hours of 12 noon and 12 midnight on Sundays, but not at any other time on Sundays.

shall evacuate all customers from the licensed facility no later than 1:30 a.m. immediately following each day of operation, and shall not allow entry of customers into the licensed facility any earlier than 8 a.m. Any license holder who is not authorized to sell intoxicating liquor on Sundays, but does conduct other business on Sundays, shall not have to observe this evacuation time on TION TIMES: Any licensee issued a weekday intoxicating liquor license Section 3. Section 4. SUNDAY EVACUATION TIMES: Any licensee issued a Sunday intoxicating liquor license shall evacuate all customers from the licensed facility no later than 12:30 a.m. (one half hour after midnight) immediately following each Sunday of operation, and shall not allow entry of customers into the licensed facility any earlier then 8 a.m. the following Monday mornings.

Section 5. STATE ELECTION DAY OPERATION: In conformity with state law, liquor license holders shall be allowed to serve intoxicating beverages as their liquor license allows during normal operating hours set out in the previous sections, on the day of any state-wide election.

Section 6. PENALTIES: Any person, whether customer, manager, owner or employee of any license holder, or any company or organization violating any provision of this ordinance shall be pullify of a misdemeanor, punishable by

guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or mprisonment 랎 more than

The city council shall have the right in its sole discretion to immediately revoke the license of any license holding a license mentioned in this ordinance, upon any violation of this ordinance. Any such license holder who suffers such revocation shall not be entitled to a refund of the license fee for any unexpired term thereof.
