

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO OPERATING TIMES OF LIQUOR LICENSEES

The City of Green Isle Ordains:

Section 1. WEEKDAY HOURS OF OPERATION. Any licensee holding a weekday intoxicating liquor license under city ordinance shall have the right to sell intoxicating beverages as their license allows, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 a.m. from Monday through Saturday. No sale of intoxicating beverages shall take place at any other time on weekdays or on Sunday at any time for the licensees mentioned in this section.

Section 2. SUNDAY HOURS OF OPERATION. Any licensee granted a Sunday intoxicating liquor license under city ordinance shall have the right to sell intoxicating beverages between the hours of 12:00 noon and 12:00 midnight on Sundays, but not at any other time on Sundays.

Section 3. WEEKDAY EVACUATION TIMES. Any licensee issued a weekday intoxicating liquor license shall evacuate all customers from the licensed facility no later than 1:30 a.m. immediately following each day of operation, and shall not allow entry of customers into the licensed facility any earlier than 8:00 a.m. Any licensee holder who is not authorized to sell intoxicating liquor on Sundays, but does conduct other business on Sundays, shall not have to observe this evacuation time on Sunday nights.

Section 4. SUNDAY EVACUATION TIMES. Any licensee issued a Sunday intoxicating liquor license shall evacuate all customers from the licensed facility no later than 12:30 a.m. (one half hour after midnight) immediately following each Sunday of operation, and shall not allow entry of customers into the licensed facility any earlier than 8:00 a.m. the following Monday mornings.


Section 5. STATE ELECTION DAY OPERATION. In conformity with state law, liquor license holders shall be allowed to serve intoxicating beverages as their license allows during normal operating hours set out in the previous sections, on the day of any state-wide election.

Section 6. PENALTIES. Any person, whether customer, manager, owner or employee of any license holder, or any company or organization violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment for not more than 90 days.

Section 7. LICENSE REVOCATION. The city council shall have the right in its sole discretion to immediately revoke the license of any licensee holding a license mentioned in this ordinance, upon any violation of this ordinance. Any such license holder who suffers such revocation shall not be entitled to a refund of the license fee for any unexpired term thereof.

Section 8. All ordinances or portions or ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect on publication.

AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

Val Kill being duly sworn, on oath says he is and during all the

times herein stated has been the Owner publisher and printer of the newspaper known as Arlington Enterprise and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50 percent of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75 percent of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Arlington in said county, established and open during regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the publisher of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966, and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the publisher of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.

hereto attached as a part hereof was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published therein in the English language, once each week,
