THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN ISLE MINNESOTA TO PROMOTE THE PUBLIC SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELFARE, HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Ordinance 52, requiring persons granted intoxicating liquor licenses in the City of Green Isle to reside within a radius of two miles of the city is hereby repealed. Hereafter, no residency requirement shall exist for the granting of a liquor license. This ordinance shall not change any of the other terms or conditions for obtaining an intoxicating liquor license as set out in other city ordinances.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication.

ORDINANCE NO. 52

SECTION 1. No person shall be granted any intoxicating liquor license in the Village of Green Isle, unless such person resides within a radius of two (2) miles of the Village of Green Isle.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 50 of the Village of Green Isle is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication.

PERTAINING TO THE GRANTING OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSES

That the hereto attached was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published therein in the English language once each week, for **90**

successive weeks; that it was first so published on Thursday, the **7th** day of **July**, 1966; and thereafter on Thursday of each week

to and including the **19th** day of **July**; and that the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being the size and kind of type used in the composition and publication of said notices, to-wit: **abcdefghijklmnopqrstuvwxyz — 8 pt.**
